### Creating the Catalog Page

The catalog page is the introduction to the book. It features the book's cover, title page, copyright statement, and chapter and page numbers. The `.ai` file for the catalog page is shown in Figure 1-1. It's named `book.ai` (where `book` is the name of the newly created book). This image can be manipulated in Illustrator or Photoshop.

**FIGURE 1-1: The basic book catalog page.** Follow these steps to create this page:

1. **Create a new document in Adobe Illustrator (or Photoshop).** The document size should be 8 inches wide by 10 inches high.
2. **Place the cursor at the top of the page, and then click and drag to lower the page at the bottom of the document (as shown on the right in Figure 1-1).**
3. **Resize the inner rectangle to 3 inches high and 10 inches wide.**
4. **Type the page title, which should match the title of your book.** See Chapter 8 to discover how to customize the title.
5. **Ctrl+click (⌘-click) to select both the top and bottom rectangles.**
6. **Use the Direct Selection tool to delete the top and bottom rectangles.** The Title page should now look like Figure 1-1.
7. **Copy and paste the page title at the top of the `book.ai` file.** In the File menu, choose Edit⇒Paste. Photoshop (and other programs) paste the title from the Illustrator document as an image into a new blank image. In the pasted graphic, add a layer for a background image.
8. **Click the menu to open the Layer Style box.**
9. **In the menu, choose Gradient.** The Gradient tool appears, as shown in

Prostaglandin D2 receptors (D-prostanoid receptors) are a family of G protein-coupled receptors for prostaglandin D2 (PGD2) and 9-deoxo-9 $\alpha$ -hydroxynorleukotriene B4 (9-d-H-LB4) and their metabolites. This family includes the DP, CRTH2, TP and CRTH2 receptors, which are closely related, and somewhat distinct from the DP2 receptor. Discovery G protein-coupled receptors are the largest superfamily of cell surface receptors and are a major family of pharmacological targets. Until recently, all known prostanoid receptors were in the class A group of G protein-coupled receptors and were known as the prostanoid receptors. However, starting in the 1990s, two more members of this family were identified and described as the DP2 receptor and the CRTH2 receptor. These receptors belong to the so-called DP, CRTH2, TP, and CRTH2 receptor family, due to the conserved sequence of the transmembrane domains of these receptors.
